To be held at Broward College in Davie, FL, the Fall Suzuki Violin Workshop will take place on Saturday, November 2, 2013 for students in Suzuki Books 1-10. Pre-Twinkle students and new families may observe any part of the Workshop. Check-in will begin at 8:30am in Building 4 and classes will begin promptly at 9:00am. Master Class lessons will be offered on a first come, first served basis on Friday, November 1, from 4:00pm to 7:30pm at Broward College room 104; on Saturday, from 2:30-3:30 pm; and on Sunday, November 3 from 9:00am to 1 pm.

*The 2013 SASF Workshop early bird tuition fee is \$105 if postmarked on or before **October 25th**. Master class lessons are available for a fee of \$35 for a 20 minute lesson; students may sign up for a maximum of two slots with the same teacher. Master class lessons are **only** offered to students participating in the Saturday portion of the workshop. A late fee of \$10 will apply for Workshop & Master class registration postmarked beginning **October 26th**. Applications will not be accepted after **October 29th**. Please mark your calendars for these important deadlines.*
